

Exhibition of woodland produced by Woodland Trust workshops on display at The Brindley, Runcorn

MOBILE phone pictures of woodland taken by Halton residents are going on display at The Brindley.

The exhibition of images were taken by people who studied on the free Fonetography workshops, run by Jeff Clarke, and organised by the Woodland Trust, via its Woodland Communities Project.

A scheme spokeswoman said: "Go and have a look at the amazing images captured on ordinary mobile phones, make a note of where your favourites were taken, then, on a crisp winter's day, you can go out to that wood and see if you can take a photo to rival those on display – or just enjoy a brisk walk."

The woods featured in the exhibition are part of the Woodland Trust's Woodland Communities Project which, with help from Big Lottery Funding and Natural England, aims to engage people with their woodland areas.

A handful of the exhibited 200-plus images have captured some negative aspects of how we use wooded areas, such as littering, but most highlight the beauty of the woodlands.

The exhibition runs from January 8-22.
